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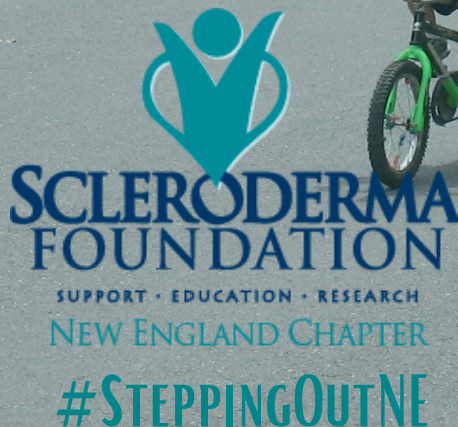

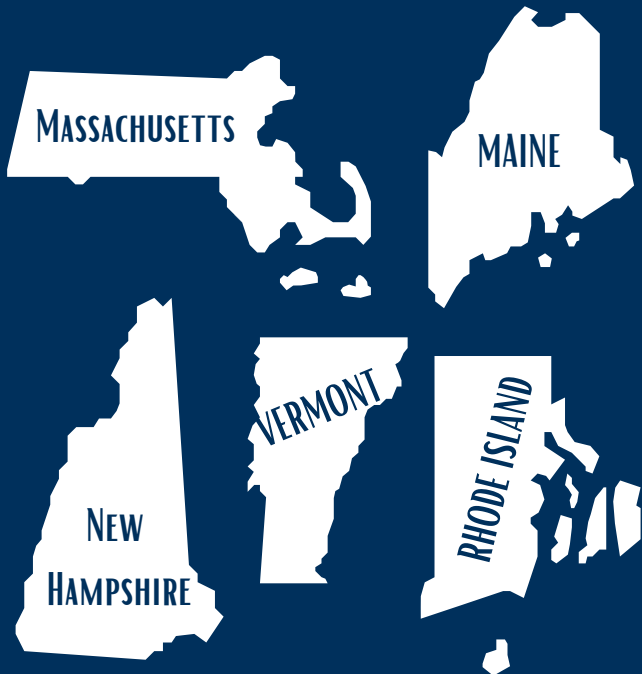

WHAT IS SCLERODERMA?

Scleroderma is a chronic, often progressive, auto immune disease in which the body's immune system attacks its own tissues. Scleroderma occurs almost four times more often in women than in men, and also affects children. The disease is not contagious, hereditary or cancerous. Symptoms may vary among individuals, and can range from mild to life-threatening. The word scleroderma is derived from the Greek (sclero) hard, (derma) skin. The disease may cause thickening or tightening of the skin, as well as serious damage to internal organs.

HOW DO WE HELP?

Scleroderma Foundation New England (SFNE) helps individuals and their families cope with the disease. A major part of the Chapter's mission is to raise funds for scleroderma research, because its cause is unknown, and there is no cure. Your help IS needed SFNE is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, and, as such, all contributions are tax deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law. We receive no government funding and are entirely dependent on contributions from the public to fund our mission.
